### DATE / TIMES

Please refer to the Essential Info Sheet for full dates and times info.

### AGE RESTRICTION

We recommend that only 18+ patrons camp at North West Festival. However, if minors are camping, they need to be accompanied AT ALL TIMES by their parent.

### INFO

Camping only applies to North West Weekender, Saturday, and VIP Weekender holders. Sorry, but no camping for Friday only ticket holders.

Campsites are not powered.

For safety reasons, once parked, vehicles in the campground cannot be moved until 6.00am on Sunday 21 August. Please use the camper's shuttle buses if you wish to leave the festival to go to the West End Markets (refer further info below).

There will be a great range of food stalls inside the festival.

For safety, please pay special attention to the restrictions on fire and flammable items (refer further info below).

Make sure you know what you can and cannot bring into the campground (refer further info below).

Please respect the site and your fellow campers. Any unruly behaviour will not be tolerated and may result in your removal from the site without refund.

In the event of an emergency, follow the directions of campground and security staff.

Please drink responsibly, and be mindful that you may still be over the legal driving limit the next day, when you head home. Police are likely to be breathalysing after the festival, so beware!

### WEST END MARKETS IN ASSOCIATION WITH NORTH WEST FESTIVAL FRINGE

At the heart of the fringe activity on Saturday 19th August, Port Hedland's favourite artisan market will be found at the Courthouse Gallery Gardens. The market will run from 9am to 1pm and will feature the very best locally handmade products, yummy international cuisine, and a variety of family friendly entertainment. A perfect way to start the day before heading for a full day of music at day two of North West Festival!

### CAMPERS SHUTTLE BUSES

There will be shuttle buses for campers from the festival campgrounds to the Saturday Morning Fringe. Shuttles will be departing every 15 minutes between 8.30am – 3.00pm. Tickets are \$3.00 return and can be purchased on the bus.

### FOOD AND DRINKS

Sorry, but no BYO alcohol. We're sorry to inform you that due to liquor licensing restrictions, there is no alcohol allowed in the campground.

We are requesting that you do your bit, and leave the alcohol at home. There will be Police and Liquor Licensing presence within the campground, and if you are found with alcohol, unfortunately, it will need to be confiscated and you may be fined. But even worse, your actions may result in the festival being shut down for the years to come.

Please do your bit to ensure the North West Festival will be a fantastic experience for all in 2016 and future years.

Sealed plastic water or soft drink bottles are allowed into the festival (note that all vessels will be opened and sniff-tested by security). Free tap water will be available inside the festival and campground from water stations. There will be a great range of food options available at the festival as part of the North West Festival experience. You can bring your own food to the festival however no glass bottles or containers please.

### ARRIVAL AND ENTRY

Vehicles are allowed in the campground and you must park in front of your tent.

Upon arrival to the campground please have your ticket ready for checking by the event staff, who will then direct you to your campsite. You will need to keep your ticket, and present it at the main festival gate in exchange for a wristband.

If you intend to camp alongside friends you must arrive together – campsites cannot be reserved.

Campsites are allocated upon arrival at the sole discretion of North West Festival staff. Ticket holders cannot choose their own site. Please stick to your allocated site and keep the lanes clear for emergency vehicles at all times.

NOTE: Once you have entered the festival, you will NOT be able to move between the festival and campground during festival hours, and you cannot take alcohol purchased at the festival bars into the campground.

Police sniffer dogs may be in operation.

### FIRES

Strictly NO FIRES of any kind (including gas and open fires, flares or fireworks) are allowed in the campground. Anyone lighting them will be removed from the site.

### SAFETY & SECURITY

Security will be patrolling the campground. Please see one of the security staff should you wish to report a disturbance or security issue.

There will be a first aid post and accessible toilet in the campground. Refer to the map for locations.

In the event of an emergency, follow the directions of the security staff.

Don't leave personal effects and valuables inside your tent. Security personnel and North West Festival camping staff will undertake regular patrols of the campground but the Town of Port Hedland and Sunset Events are not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items.

Bring only your credit or key card that you will need for the weekend. Leave all valuables and unnecessary cards at home.

### RESPECT THY NEIGHBOUR

Please show respect for your fellow campers and our nearby neighbours and keep the noise down. If you want to stay up after the festival concludes

each night, an area inside the festival will remain open where you can get something to eat and drink and chill out, but please be mindful of those who are seeking some quiet time when moving around the campground.

Get to know your neighbour and keep a look out over them – alert a security staff member if they need medical attention and keep a watch over their possessions.

### TOILETS & SHOWERS

For your convenience, toilets are located in the campground (as well as inside the festival).

Campground showers are accessible at all times during the festival.

Check the site map for the location of toilets and showers. Please take short showers to save water and allow other campers to have a shower. Please report any shower or toilet cleaning or operating problems to campground staff.

### RUBBISH

Please help us keep the campground clean and put your waste in the bins provided or take your waste with you. Our friendly campground staff will be handing out rubbish bags when you arrive.

Please don't drop your cigarette butts on the ground. Put them in the bins provided.

### HERE'S A LIST OF THINGS YOU SHOULD BRING:

- Your valid photo ID (refer to the festival info for details) and ticket.
- Small 2-3-man tent (including a fly sheet).
- Sleeping bag.
- Hat, sunscreen.
- A beach towel or bath towel.
- Warm clothing as it WILL get cold after dark.
- Some comfy, enclosed shoes.
- A torch (with charged batteries).
- Sealed, plastic water bottle – glass bottles are not permitted. Please drink lots of water.
- Mosquito / fly repellent.
- Enough cash to get you through the festival.
- A padlock for your tent.

### LEAVE AT HOME:

- Drums of any kind or sporting equipment.
- Large tents.
- Any unsealed bottles.
- Glass vessels or containers.
- Crates.
- Anything that may be used as a weapon.
- Animals (although guide dogs are permitted).
